



Say No to Tax by Mile

An unelected bureaucracy called the Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) released a plan in 2016 with the intent to redesign Southern California so that the automobile is no longer needed. The total cost of the plan is half a trillion dollars and it's main funding source is a vehicle mileage tax.
